What is included?

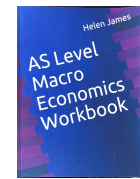
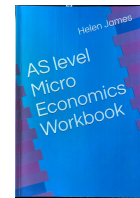
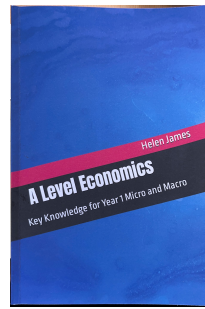
- 1 hour lesson each week (see timetable for the weeks included)

- Suggested reading each week to be completed ahead of the lesson (optional)
- Short answer workbook questions to be completed after each lesson to test understanding (optional)

Aim of the Classes

- Small enough that students have plenty of opportunity to ask questions
- Increased confidence
- Master the important concepts
- Interactive - I will be asking plenty of questions to check understanding
- Focus on the trickier parts of the specification
- More individual feedback than in a large class
- Learn how to answer exam style questions and jump through the hoops to get the marks
- The same order of topics that most year 12 will be covering at school
- Also suitable for year 13 who need a refresher of the year 12 topics and guidance on exam technique

How to get the most out of the Lessons

- The table on the next page shows the topics which will be covered each week
- I have suggested two sets of reading each week. 1) My knowledge book (which I will post) - I strongly suggest reading this ahead of the lesson 2) Edexcel 'My Revision Notes' which can be bought on Amazon - if time allows then reading this as well will be valuable.
- After the lesson students should attempt the workbook questions (which I will post), these will test their understanding and cover some elements we may not have had time for.
- Any queries which arise from the workbook questions can be raised at the start of the next lesson
- I appreciate that some students get a lot of school work so may not have time for the reading and questions, however, they will get more out of the course if they can complete them.
