Year 12 Small Group Class


- Starting Wb 23rd Sept (time and day TBC)


What is included?

Aim of the Classes

- Interactive students work on a private whiteboard so I can check what they are doing and give feedback
- Focus on the trickier parts of the specification
- More individual feedback than in a large class
- Learn how to answer exam style questions and jump through the hoops to get the marks

- Also suitable for year 13 who need a refresher of the year 12 topics and guidance on exam technique
