



Year 12 Small Group Class

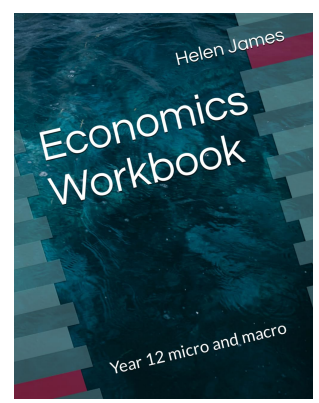
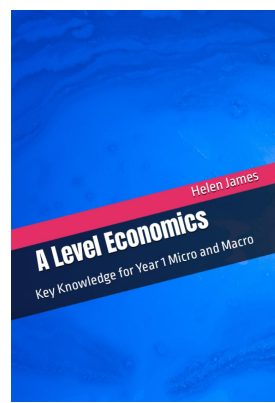
- Starting Wednesday 17th/Thursday 18th September 7.50pm

What is included?

Aim of the Classes

- Interactive - students work on a private whiteboard so I can check what they are doing and give feedback
- Focus on the trickier parts of the specification
- More individual feedback than in a large class
- Learn how to answer exam style questions and jump through the hoops to get the marks
- The same order of topics that **most** year 12 will be covering at school.
- Also suitable for year 13 who need a refresher of the year 12 topics and guidance on exam technique
