



Year 12 Small Group Class

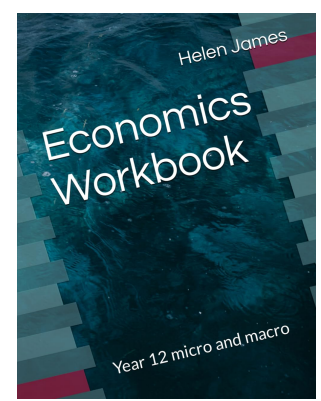
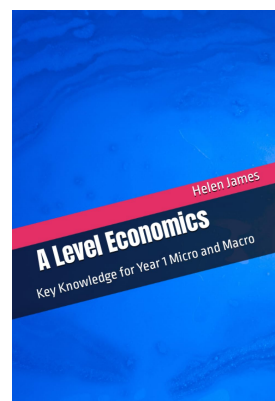
- Starting Monday 21st Sept 7.50pm

What is included?
